

Chalk Stream Water Invertebrates



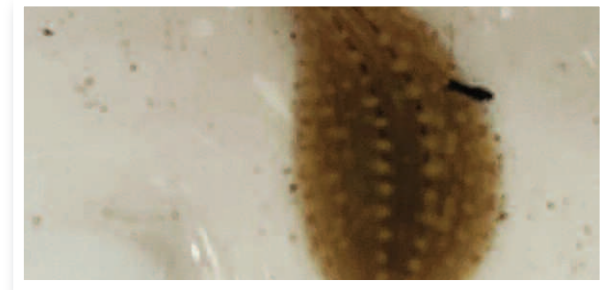
MAYFLY-OLIVE

Find their 3 tails & note their darting swimming behaviour



CASED CADDIS FLY

These larvae make a home from tiny stones, twigs or leaves.



LEECH

These will not suck your blood! They feed on detritus or other invertebrates



BLOODWORM

These live in any kind of water habitat



TRUE MAYFLY

Look for their 3 tails and feathery gills.



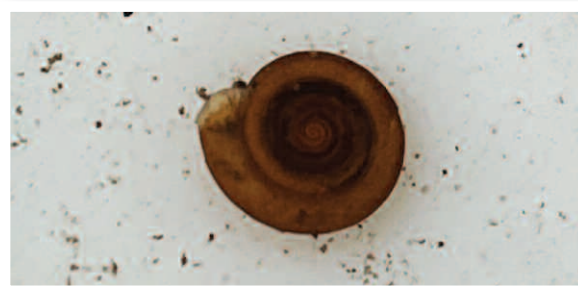
FRESHWATER SHRIMP

Found in large numbers, likes clean water



CASELESS CADDIS FLY

Note their squirmy swimming and the hooks at the end of the tail



RAMSHORN SNAIL

A small circular snail

An alien looking invert that will turn into a beautiful damselfly

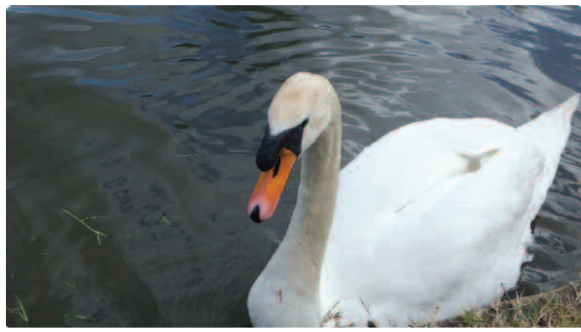
